### Outside Greeters

**What it is:**

Thank you for agreeing to be an outside greeter.

The job of outside greeter is to be a friendly welcoming assistant to people who may need help with getting into and out of their car and into the church and/or parking and retrieving their car. Outside greeters are especially needed in the snow and ice conditions of winter. During the winter the plan is to have two outside greeters: one for the front entrance and one for the back door. During late summer and early fall, only one outside greeter will be scheduled. The main task will be the same: to greet people and assist them as needed.

**Why we do it:**

To make sure that people can get in and out of church safely and to provide a welcoming environment for both members and visitors.

**What we do:**

Guidelines for Outside Greeters

1. Be outside the front or back door ready to greet the congregation 30 minutes before the service start time: 10AM in winter and 9AM in summer.
2. Offer to help people into the church as appropriate, especially in winter with snowy/icy conditions.
3. After the service, help people out.

If you cannot be an Outside Greeter on the date you are assigned, please attempt to swap with someone. If you cannot arrange a swap, please contact the Membership & Evangelism member of the month (printed in each week's bulletin, the newsletter, and in the eUpdate email).

**Time Commitment:**

Approximately 45 minutes.

**Number of volunteers needed:**

Two per Sunday, rotating around throughout the year.
